1. ORGANIZATION OVERVIEW

2. ENDOFRANCE

EndoFrance has been accredited by the Ministry of Health since September 2018 and by the Ministry of National Education since January 2024. For over 20 years, it has been supporting and informing people affected by endometriosis and those around them, raising awareness, and working with public authorities and healthcare professionals to improve the care pathway and reduce diagnostic delays.

3. THE THEME OF THE 2026 HEALTH CALL FOR PROJECTS

« **Endometriosis: advancing research together** » : Altrad Solidarity, in partnership with EndoFrance, is launching the 2026 health call for projects.

The endowment fund wishes to highlight research projects of general interest on the theme of endometriosis, in particular:

- Understanding endometriosis
- Improving diagnosis
- Better understanding and managing symptoms
- Exploring treatments and therapeutic strategies

Projects may cover any field of research contributing to a better understanding of endometriosis. The topics presented above are given for illustrative purposes only and do not constitute an exhaustive list of eligible projects.

Basic, clinical, epidemiological, and technological research, as well as research in the humanities and social sciences, may in particular be submitted.

Any research proposal offering new insight into endometriosis and contributing to the development of knowledge in this field may be considered.

Altrad Solidarity may fund research projects up to a limit of €100,000 per project.

4. RULES

4.1. Application and eligibility criteria

- Be recognized as a public-interest organization with disinterested management
- Have independent governance
- Help develop the power to act of your target audiences
- Have the capacity to integrate and promote diversity, inclusion, and gender equality
- Have a demonstrable, measurable impact – evaluable in nature
- Take place within a territory of the European Union
- Have fundraising costs or research management costs below 30%
- Have at least 2 employees and/or have existed for at least one year
- The candidate's project falls within the scope described in Article 3, "The theme of the 2026 health call for projects"

The following are not eligible:

- Religious/worship-related projects
- Individual projects
- Organizations whose mission is political or religious in nature
- Projects that are for-profit, promotional, or advertising in nature
- Organizations that have recently had negative repercussions or that do not meet recognized UN ethical standards
- Organizations that do not comply with the Altrad Group's compliance policy
- Organizations or projects that are not eligible under the French corporate sponsorship (mécénat) scheme.

4.2. Application file

Any incomplete application, or one that does not include all requested documents, cannot be processed.

Applications open:
9 September 2026 at 8:00 a.m.

Applications close:
21 October 2026 at 12:00 a.m.

At any point during the selection process, Altrad Solidarity reserves the right to contact applicants to request any additional information or documents needed to review their application.

Shortlisted applications will then be reviewed by a panel. The panel is made up of Altrad Solidarity's operational team, EndoFrance's research team, and Altrad Solidarity's employee committee and board of directors. The panel's review of applications will take place during November 2026. All applicants will be contacted during December 2026.

4.3. Evaluation criteria

Projects must meet our eligibility criteria and support an organization whose impact is concrete, measured, and measurable.

Altrad Solidarity does not cover costs incurred by advocacy actions and will pay particular attention to the following criteria:

- The relevance of the topic in light of current unmet needs
- The number of project beneficiaries
- The operational aspect of the supported project
- The feasibility of the project

4.4. Award Recipients

Altrad Solidarity's financial support to award recipients will be formalized through a sponsorship agreement (convention de mécénat) setting out the terms of the support and the obligations of the parties.

Supported projects will be monitored and evaluated by Altrad Solidarity throughout their implementation in order to oversee the use of funds and assess results.

4.5. Personal Data and Confidentiality

The personal data collected as part of this call for applications is processed by Altrad Solidarity, acting as data controller, in accordance with Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 (GDPR) and amended French Law No. 78-17 of 6 January 1978 on data processing, data files, and civil liberties.

This data is collected and processed solely for the purposes of reviewing, evaluating, and managing applications submitted as part of Altrad Solidarity's initiatives. This processing is based on Altrad Solidarity's legitimate interest in selecting and managing candidate projects. The data is accessible only to authorized persons responsible for reviewing applications, as well as to panel members bound by a duty of confidentiality.

Personal data is retained for the period necessary to review the application and manage any follow-up action. At the end of this period, it is archived or deleted in accordance with applicable legal obligations and Altrad Solidarity's data retention policy.

In accordance with applicable regulations, you have the right to access, rectify, erase, and restrict the processing of your personal data, and, where the conditions are met, to object to such processing. You may exercise these rights by sending your request to: contact@Altrad-solidarity.com.

If, after contacting us, you believe that your rights are not being respected, you may file a complaint with the CNIL (www.cnil.fr).

4.6. Amendment and Cancellation
